**DO OVER: BUT GOD**

### I. THREE TRUTHS TO HELP YOU STAND STRONG

<sup>13</sup>That same day two of Jesus' followers were walking to the village of Emmaus, seven miles from Jerusalem. <sup>14</sup>As they walked along they were talking about everything that had happened. <sup>15</sup>As they talked and discussed these things, Jesus himself suddenly came and began walking with them. <sup>16</sup>But God kept them from recognizing him. <sup>17</sup>He asked them, "What are you discussing so intently as you walk along?" They stopped short, sadness written across their faces. <sup>18</sup>Then one of them, Cleopas, replied, "You must be the only person in Jerusalem who hasn't heard about all the things that have happened there the last few days." <sup>19</sup>"What things?" Jesus asked.

"The things that happened to Jesus, the man from Nazareth," they said. "He was a prophet who did powerful miracles, and he was a mighty teacher in the eyes of God and all the people. <sup>20</sup>But our leading priests and other religious leaders handed him over to be condemned to death, and they crucified him. <sup>21</sup>We had hoped he was the Messiah who had come to rescue Israel. This all happened three days ago." – Luke 24:13-21 (NLT)

There they found the eleven disciples and the others who had gathered with them, <sup>34</sup>who said, "The Lord has really risen! He appeared to Peter." – Luke 24:30-34 (NLT)
