1) _____: **To rave, boast, celebrate, to be clamorously foolish.**

“I will thank you in front of the great assembly. I will praise you before all the people.” – Psalm 35:18 (NLT)

2) _____: **To acknowledge in public**

“I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart.” – Psalm 138:1

3) _____: **To bless by kneeling or bowing**

“Praise the LORD, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name.” – Psalm 103:1

4) _____: **Making music to God with strings**

“It is good to praise the LORD and make music to your name, O Most High.” – Psalm 92:1

5) _____: **To address in a loud tone, to shout.**

“Because your love is better than life, my lips will glorify you. I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands.” – Psalm 63:3-4

6) _____: **To lift hands in adoration**

“He who offers praise glorifies me: and to him that orders his conversation aright will I show the salvation of God.” – Psalm 50:23

7) _____: **Exuberant singing**

“I will extol the LORD at all times; his praise will always be on my lips.” – Psalm 34:1
