#### THE WAY OF PURPOSED PAIN

"And we know that in <u>all things</u> <u>God works for the good</u> of those who love him, who have been called <u>according to his purpose</u>." – Romans 8:28

### 1. Don't just look at life from a \_\_\_\_\_

"Now a man named <u>Lazarus was sick</u>. He was from Bethany, the village of Mary and her sister Martha. (This Mary, whose brother Lazarus now lay sick, was the same one who poured perfume on the Lord and wiped his feet with her hair.) So the sisters sent word to Jesus, "Lord, the one you love is sick." – John 11:1-3

"When he heard this, Jesus said, "This sickness will not end in death. ... Now Jesus loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. So when he heard that Lazarus was sick, he stayed where he was two more days..."

– John 11:4-6a

"So then he told them plainly, "Lazarus is dead, and for your sake <u>I am glad I was not there</u>..."

– John 11:14-15a

"Lord," Martha said to Jesus, "<u>if you had been</u> here, my brother would not have died..."When Mary reached the place where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet and said, "Lord, <u>if you had been here</u>, my brother would not have died." – John 11:21, 32

"But some of them said, "<u>Could not he</u> who opened the eyes of the blind man have <u>kept this man from</u> <u>dying</u>?"" – John 11:37

## 2. See your pain from a \_\_\_\_\_

"When he heard this, Jesus said, "This sickness will not end in death. No, <u>it is for God's glory so that God's</u> Son may be glorified through it." – John 11:4

"So then he told them plainly, "Lazarus is dead, and for your sake I am glad I was not there, <u>so that you may</u> <u>believ</u>e. But let us go to him." – John 11:14-15

"Lord," Martha said to Jesus, "if you had been here, my brother would not have died... Jesus said to her, "Your <u>brother will rise again</u>."... Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who <u>believes in me</u> will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by <u>believing in me</u> will never die. <u>Do you believe this</u>?" – John 11:21-26

"Then Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?"" – John 11:40

## 3. The pain is \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the purpose
