#### JESUS THE LAMB

"The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, <u>the Lamb of God</u>, who takes away the sin of the world!" – John 1:29

"And when your children ask you, "<u>What does this ceremony mean to you</u>?" then tell them, "It is the Passover sacrifice to the LORD, who passed over the houses of the Israelites in Egypt and spared our homes when he struck down the Egyptians." – Exodus 12:26-27

"And he said to them, "I have eagerly desired to eat this <u>Passover</u> with you before I suffer. For I tell you, I will not eat it again until it finds <u>fulfillment</u> in the kingdom of God."
