

"And who gave you this authority?" Jesus replied, "I will also ask you one question. If you answer me, I will tell you by what authority I am doing these things. John's baptism—where did it come from? Was it from heaven, or of human origin?" They discussed it among themselves and said, "If we say, 'From heaven,' he will ask, 'Then why didn't you believe him?' For I was hungry and you gave me <u>nothing</u> to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me <u>nothing</u> to drink, I was a stranger and you <u>did not</u> invite me in, I needed clothes and you <u>did not</u> clothe me, I was sick and in prison and you did not look after me.' "They also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help you?' "He will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you <u>did not do for one of the least</u> of these, you <u>did not do for me</u>. "Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."
