*“Now it was the custom at that time to release a prisoner when the people requested it. A man named Barabbas was in prison with the insurrectionist who had committed murder and the uprising. The crowd came up and asked Pilate to do for them what he usually did. Pilate says, ‘Do you want me to release to you Jesus, the King of the Jews?’ Knowing it was out of self-interest that the chief priest had handed Jesus over to him but the chief priest stirred up the crowd to have Pilate release Barabbas instead. Pilate then says, ‘What shall I do with the one you call the King of the Jews?’ They shouted in response, ‘Crucify Him!’ ‘Why?’ Pilate asked, ‘What crime has He committed?’ And they shouted the louder, ‘Crucify Him!’” – Mark 15:6-14*

*“The soldiers led Jesus away into the palace (that is, the Praetorium) and called together the whole company of soldiers. They put a purple robe on him, then twisted together a crown of thorns and set it on him. And they began to call out to him, “Hail, king of the Jews!” Again and again they struck him on the head with a staff and spit on him. Falling on their knees, they paid homage to him. And when they had mocked him, they took off the purple robe and put his own clothes on him. Then they led him out to crucify him. “ – Mark 15:16-20*

**POWER IN THE BLOOD**

*“At noon, darkness came over the whole land until three in the afternoon. And at three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, “Eloi, Eloi, lema sabachthani?” (which means “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”)... With a loud cry, Jesus breathed his last. The curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom.” – Mark 15:37-38*
