## Safe Child Policy Acknowledgment Form for VBS Volunteers (Con't) **Discipline** Initial Discipline will be carried out through instruction, training, correction and positive reinforcement. PHYSICAL PUNISHMENT AND HUMILIATION SHALL NEVER BE USED. The following steps should be followed upon observing inappropriate behavior: Identify the inappropriate behavior and explain why it is inappropriate; Suggest an alternative behavior; Remind the child or youth that if the action continues a consequence will ensue; Physical contact should be limited to a gentle restraint; For second offenses, follow-through with the consequence; After taking action, remind the child or youth of an alternative behavior, and; For third offenses, the child or youth should be removed from the activity and the parents of the child or youth shall be contacted. In extreme cases where the child or youth becomes a threat to him/herself or others, remove the child or youth from the room. Do not leave the child or youth unattended; and VBS program leader shall be contacted for any situation that cannot be handled in accordance with the above guidelines. **Drop-off Procedures** Initial No child should be left in a classroom or program area without the teacher or adult leader person. **Parent Pick-up** Initial Children will be released only to a parent, legal quardian, or authorized adult following VBS. Teachers/volunteers should not leave the program area until all children have been released appropriately. Parents may authorize their child to be released to another adult or family member. A parent or responsible adult must supervise children at all times. No child should be left unsupervised in the Church building or on the Church grounds.
