## ATTRIBUTES OF BOLDNESS

### ■ Boldness stands on \_\_\_\_\_

*“But there are some Jews whom you have set over the affairs of the province of Babylon—Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego—who pay no attention to you, Your Majesty. They neither serve your gods nor worship the image of gold you have set up.”*

– Daniel 3:12

### ■ Boldness declares \_\_\_\_\_ in God’s power

*“If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it, and he will deliver us from Your Majesty’s hand.”*

– Daniel 3:17

### ■ Boldness almost always triggers \_\_\_\_\_

*“They arrested the apostles and put them in the public jail.”*

– Acts 5:18 (NLT)

*“Then Nebuchadnezzar...commanded some of the strongest soldiers in his army to tie up Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego and throw them into the blazing furnace.”*

– Daniel 3:19-20

### ■ Boldness often releases \_\_\_\_\_

*“But an angel of the Lord came at night, opened the gates of the jail, and brought them out.”*

– Acts 5:19 (NLT)

*“So Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego came out of the fire,...They saw that the fire had not harmed their bodies, nor was a hair of their heads singed; their robes were not scorched, and there was no smell of fire on them.”*

– Daniel 3:27

### ■ Boldness always \_\_\_\_\_

*“Go to the Temple and give the people this message of life!” <sup>21</sup>So at daybreak the apostles entered the Temple, as they were told, and immediately began teaching.”*
